

LICENSE

Our center is a religious sponsored child care facility and is licensed through the state under a GS-110. We are regulated by the Division of Child Development and Early Education. We are inspected annually by the Division of Child Development, the Sanitation Department of Cabarrus County and the Fire Marshall. Our program chooses to exceed requirements in areas such as staff qualifications, curriculum and overall compliance.

STAFF

- Staff meet or exceed educational qualifications and are dedicated to teaching and caring for children.
- All staff must undergo background checks and are subject to random drug testing.
- Staff participate in professional development activities and staff meetings.
- Staff are trained in CPR and First Aid.
- We require any staff person to be at least 18 years old and be a high school graduate.

CURRICULUM

Our curriculum stimulates the growth and development of each child in all areas including physical, social, emotional, cognitive and language.

Bible stories and related activities enhance spiritual growth and development of good character. We understand that building a sound foundation in the early years will have a positive impact on a child's later development and success in school and in life.

MENU

Our menu operates on a 5-week rotation that follows the state nutrition guidelines. We are a peanut-free facility.

REGISTRATION

A Registration Fee of \$50.00 is due upon enrollment and is non-refundable. An annual registration fee is due each September for all students.

TUITION

Tuition is weekly and based on a full day full time status. Sibling discounts are available. Payment can be made by check, cash or money order.

PARENT HANDBOOK

Upon registration, parents will receive a Parent's Handbook.

BEFORE AND AFTER SCHOOL

Harrisburg Presbyterian Church Child Development Center offers before and after school care and full time Summer Camp for Kindergarten students through age 12. We service Harrisburg Elementary School, Patriots Elementary School, Rocky River Elementary School and Pitts School Road Elementary School. We offer full day care for children out on early release school days, Christmas and Spring breaks.

ACTIVITIES

Children are provided outdoor play time, weather permitting, free play, homework time, art activities, and indoor games. Occasionally movies will be shown, or books read to students including a Bible Story.

SUMMER CAMP FOR SCHOOL AGE CHILDREN

Our Summer Camp will begin the day after school ends in Cabarrus County for the summer. It includes weekly themes and may include activities such as swimming, bowling, skating, field trips, movies and popcorn, visits from the ice cream truck, crafts, games and activities in the gym, and plenty of outside play.

Breakfast, lunch and a snack is served each day unless the group is participating in a field trip that includes the children eating away from the center.

HOURS OF OPERATION

We open every weekday at 6:30 am and close at 6:00 pm.
